In the string world, serious problems can develop if students aren't getting the 1-on-1 time with a teacher in private lessons. Many problems are ingrained into a student if they start a string instrument without private lessons. It can be an uphill battle trying to get students to correct bad habits. There is no way their bad habits are going to get fixed in a school setting. School class settings should be utilized for musicality, and learning to play well with others.
